We are a vibrant, welcoming church with a passion for encouraging and supporting children & families in our congregation and parish. We seek an enthusiastic person to join our team, to engage with children of all ages and their families, both within the doors of our church building and within our wider community

About us

St Michael & All Angels is an Anglican church in a parish within easy reach of High Wycombe. The church building is in Hughenden Park.

We are a welcoming family church, with children and young people especially important to us. We support three primary schools in the parish and an independent day school for girls.

At the heart of what we do lies the worship of God our Father as we seek to live out our lives as followers of Jesus his Son. We seek to meet the spiritual needs of all who come, of whatever age and background.

Our vision is:

To know God's love and to share that love with everyone.

Our current position

Our passion is for our children and young people to grow in faith, equipped and released to live for God. We have great relationships with the children who have grown up with us and who are now actively engaged as youth.

We have volunteer-led children's provision at our 11 am service for most Sundays. On the first Sunday is an "all age" service, where we encourage the children and youth to participate.

We have had occasional evening youth groups and outings. We have previously run Youth Alpha and Youth Christianity Explored and, pre-pandemic, our volunteers ran Messy Church once a month.

The clergy take turns to prepare and deliver Collective Worship at Great Kingshill School once a week. We also work with Wycombe Youth for Christ to deliver “Christmas Unwrapped” and “Easter Explained” for Year 6 children from local schools.

About you

Benefits and rewards
